- 5. Description of the individual (Age, sex, race, residency, proximity, social skills, education levels, work history, military history, appearance, personality, etc.)
- 6. Their background or family histories.
- 7. Dates suspected to be active in the killings.
- 8. How many people did they kill (charged for, admitted, and suspected).
- 9. Reason for selecting those victims.
- 10. Their MO's and signatures.
- 11. Their organization level (organized, disorganized, mixed), and evidence of this.
- 12. Their motives (including any delusions, hallucinations, fantasies, etc.)
- 13. How were they caught? When were they caught?
- 14. Other information.
